



Animal Dominoes



Rules

For 2 to 4 Players • Ages 3 & Up

Contents: 36 Dominoes

Object: Be the first player to run out of Dominoes.

Set Up:

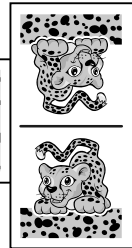
- Shuffle all the Dominoes face down. If there are 2 players, each player take 7 Dominoes to form your hand. If there are 3 or 4 players, each should take 5 Dominoes. Place your Dominoes face up in front of yourself. Leave the extra Dominoes in a pile to draw from later.

Play:

- Decide who goes first and then take turns.
- On your turn, place any Domino face

up in the middle of the playing surface. Then, play passes to the left.

- Try to match the picture of a Domino in your hand to either end of the Dominoes on the playing surface.
- You may lay only one Domino down on your turn. If you are unable to match a Domino, you must draw one from the pile on the table. If you can play it, do so. If you can't play it, your turn ends. If there are no Dominoes left to draw from, your turn ends.
- If you play a double Domino, you must lay it crosswise in the line.



Winning: If you're first to get rid of all your Dominoes, say "Domino!" You win!
