

Of Fluttery Butterflies

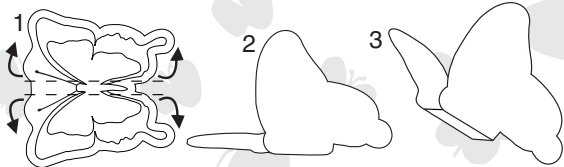


For 2 to 4 Players • Ages 4 & Up

Contents: 19 Butterflies, 1 Moth, 4 Flowers, 40 Cards, Rules

Object: Collect 5 beautiful Butterflies on your Flower.

Set Up: Punch out all the Butterflies, and crease their wings, as shown below.



Punch out the Flowers. Shuffle the cards and place them in a pile, face down, in the center where everybody can reach them. This will be the draw pile. Spread out all the Butterflies around the draw pile. Take a Flower and place it in front of yourself.

Play: Everybody take turns. If this is your game, you go first. Turn over the top card on the pile and place it face up next to the draw pile to start the discard pile. If the card you turn over shows...



A Butterfly- take the matching Butterfly and put it on your Flower. Then your turn is over.

A Caterpillar- do nothing and then your turn is over

The Moth- take the Moth and put it on your Flower. You may have to take the Moth from the center, or you may have to take it off the Flower of another player. No matter where the Moth is when you draw a Moth card, you **MUST** take it and put it on your Flower. Nobody wants to get the Moth. If you draw a Moth card and you already have the Moth on your Flower, you have to leave it there and your turn is over.

Winning: If you're the first player to get 5 Butterflies on your Flower and **NOT** have the Moth, you are the winner!

If you have five Butterflies or more and still have the Moth, somebody else will have to draw a Moth card and take the Moth away from you before you can win.
